ECA Group delivers H300 ROV in France

ECA Group has delivered an [H300 MK2](#) ROV to France's Satif Ouvrage d'Art for inspection and intervention operations on immersed structures, the company announced on 27 February.

The ROV has been equipped with a scanning sonar and an imaging sonar, both mounted on a skid assembly beneath the ROV. The vehicle is also equipped with a precise positioning system linked to surface operators by a fibre-optic umbilical cable.

The H300 ROV can perform intervention up to 300m depth. It can be equipped with a wide range of additional equipment for inspection and surveillance, such as rear and 3D TV cameras and digital still camera; manipulator arms; and additional sensors.

Both ROV and additional equipment can be controlled through a single and ergonomic control unit. The umbilical cable is housed on a manual winch and equipped with a slip ring assembly.

Satif Ouvrage d'Art provides inspection and intervention on immersed structures such as bridges, locks, dams or water treatment plants.
